Child Protection Act 2002

Chapter I

Interpretations / General rules

Article 1

In this act, unless the context otherwise requires –

2. Child protection means every activities done to ensure and protect children’s rights to live, growth, advance, and participate optimally along with humanity, as well as getting protection from abusive treatment and discrimination.
3. Family means the smallest unit of community consists of husband and wife, or both of them with their children, or father and his children, or mother and her children, or three direct bloodline generation family ties.
4. Parents mean father and/or mother, or stepfather and/or stepmother, or foster father and/or foster mother.
5. Guardian means people or organization which take primary responsibility as parents for the children.
7. Handicapped children mean children having physical and/or mental disabilities which could result in the hindrance of their development normally.
8. Talented children mean children being exceptionally diligent, or having exceptional ability and/or talent.
